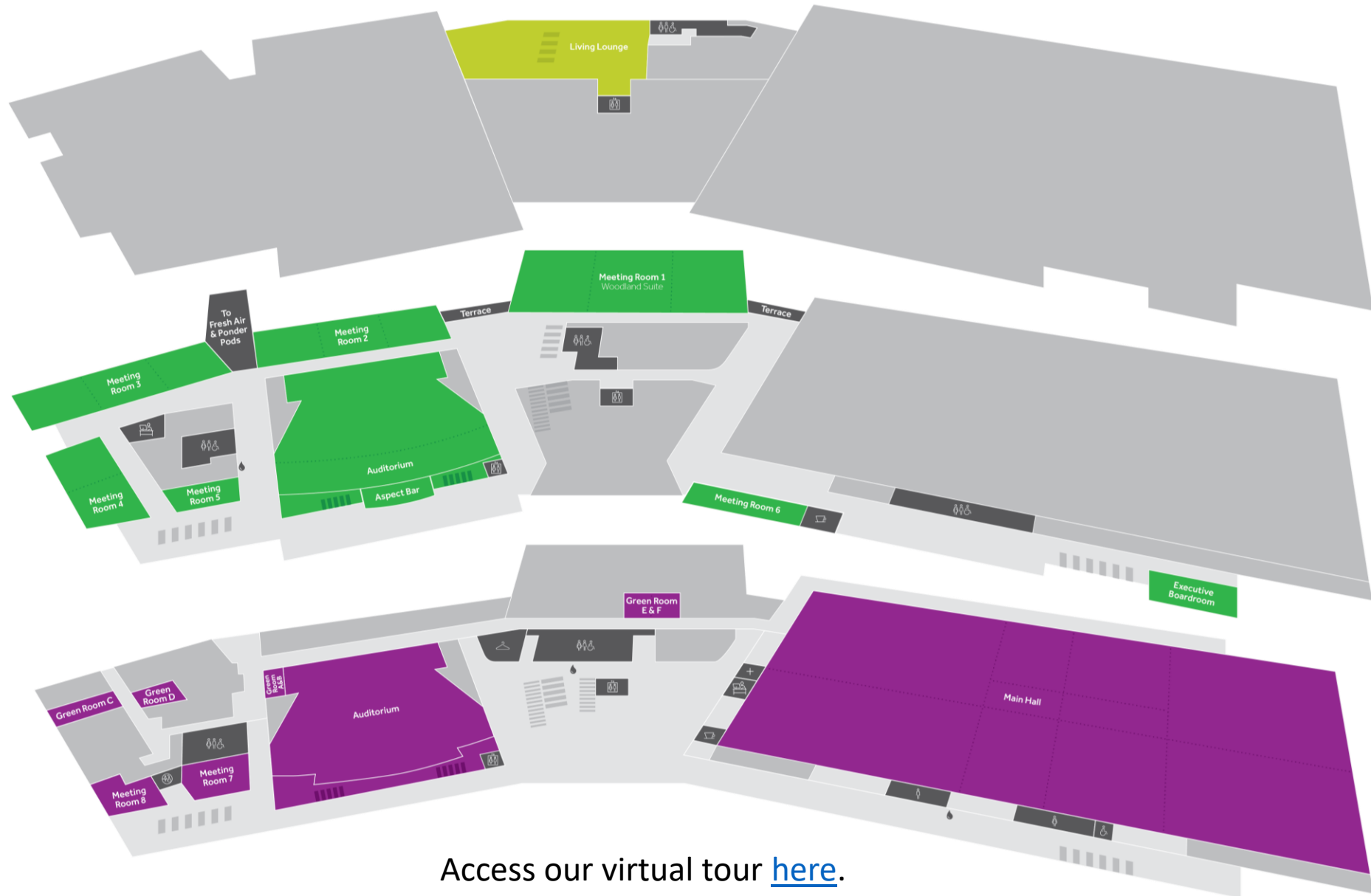

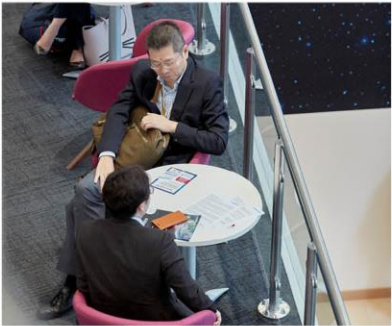


ICC WALES ROOM CAPACITIES & DIMENSIONS

The exciting exhibition space at ICC Wales is a vast 4,000sqm of pillar free carpeted hall, with handy direct loading for production vehicles.

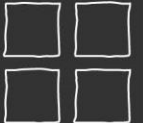

NETWORKING SPACES

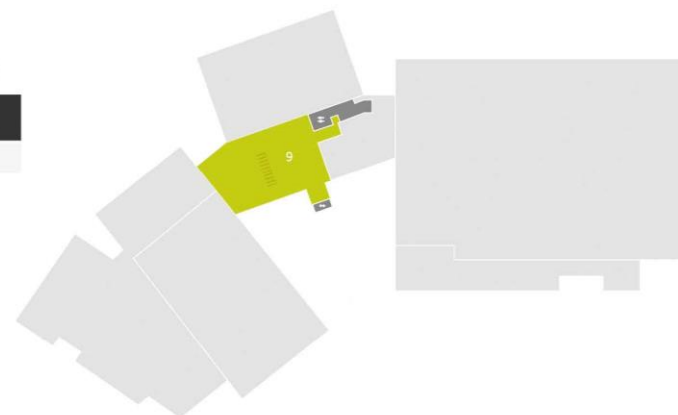

WI-FI & IT

Venue has full Wi-Fi capability service by Ruckus high density points access.

- + Complimentary delegate Wi-Fi included in fee up to 5 meg per device, this can be flexed on request to 30 meg per device, alternately a dedicated secure VLAN network for specific events can be set up, segregating the traffic for the event in question
- + Dedicated team Wi-Fi and support
- + Hardwired connection for registration to support online delegate payments
- + Hardwired connections can be supplied to most points in the building
- + 10 Gigabit circuit running at 2 Gigabit (uncontested fibre) capable of being flexed up to 10 Gigabit, complemented by a 1 Gigabit circuit by separate vendor for resilience
- + Internal backbone network will be on a 10 Gigabit platform with full resilience, including Core switch
- + Venue has full Wi-Fi capability service by 133 Ruckus high density access points. Total Wi-Fi capacity for venue is in excess of 10,000 connected devices at any one time
- + SIP infrastructure serviced by an IP-based PABX solution that could be used to offer dedicated fixed line telephony
- + Internal mobile phone coverage will be serviced by Vodafone, EE and O2 with infrastructure to support 5G from 2021
- + Digital signage runs on a Triple Play platform - content management can be controlled by client or venue
- + LED video wall in atrium is 6912mm x 4096mm and has a pitch of 3.1mm. It can also run Triple Play, TV or media feeds and can be connected to PA system if required for audio
- + Video conferencing is available through the use of Skype or Zoom accounts which is pre-installed in several boardrooms

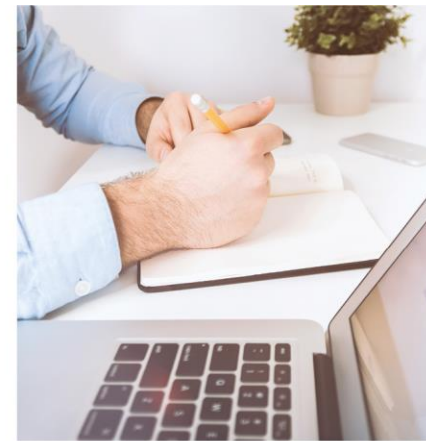

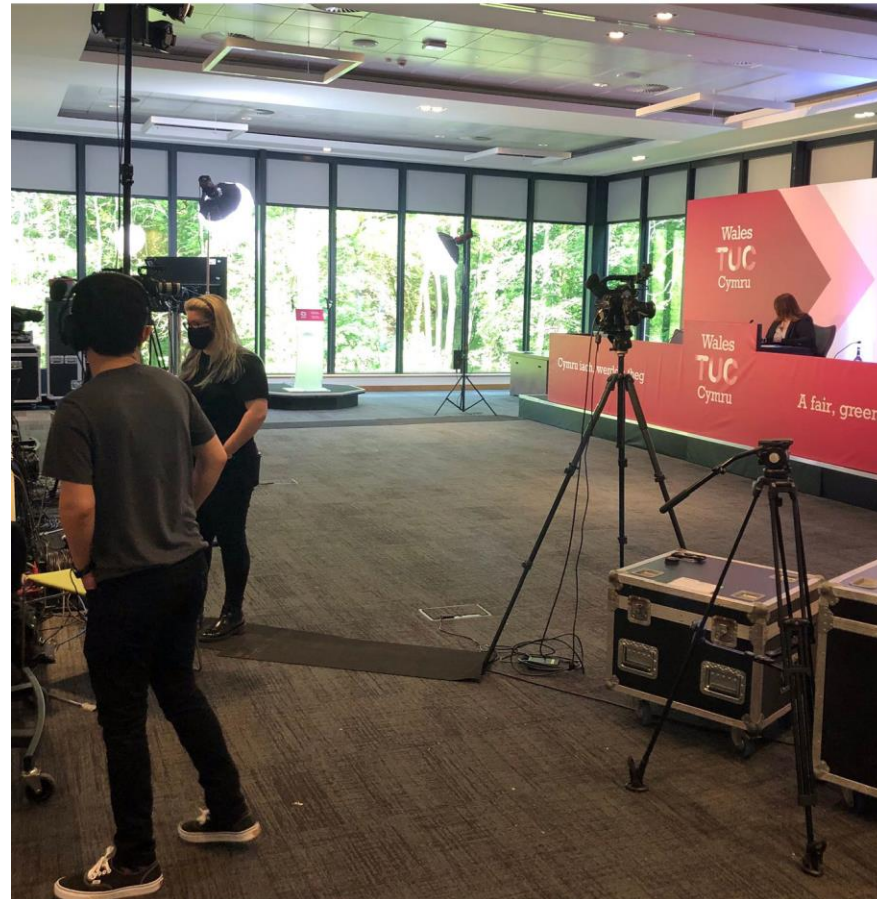

HYBRID

A mixture of in-person and remote attendance for a live event. Both presenters and delegates can either be in the building, or accessing the event remotely.

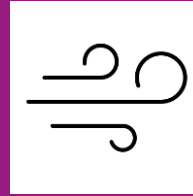

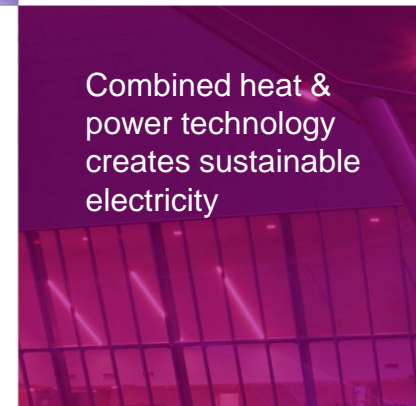

OUR SUSTAINABILITY JOURNEY - TODAY

ICC Wales sits within the estate of the Celtic Manor which has 2,000 acres of stunning parkland and 230 acres of woodland in the Usk Valley which naturally offsets 465 tonnes of CO₂ annually making a contribution to the carbon neutral target. We planted over 5,000 trees last year and our plan is to continue to manage our parklands and woodlands effectively to play our part in the fight against climate change.

Our journey cannot happen without people and we have a dedicated team who are responsible for making it happen. From our dedicated Energy and Sustainability Manager to our Working Groups – an enthusiastic team of individuals who are passionate about our planet, our country and our venues, to our Senior Management Team who task their Management Teams to take responsibility for their individual areas to continually improve the work that we all do to improve our sustainability credentials – we all recognise the part that we play.



OUR SUSTAINABILITY JOURNEY - TODAY

When our Architects were designing ICC Wales, their brief was to make our venue as sustainable as possible, and this has been achieved by using both traditional and new technologies.

ICC Wales was designed to be flooded with natural daylight, we have 100% energy saving LEDs (and AV Equipment) throughout and our lighting is carefully controlled by a sophisticated Building Management System and Passive Infrared Sensors to ensure that our energy usage is minimised.

The Atrium, spacious foyers and underground car parking have natural ventilation which means that these areas are automatically vented and passively cooled naturally which saves energy. In addition, ICC Wales is powered 100% with renewable energy.

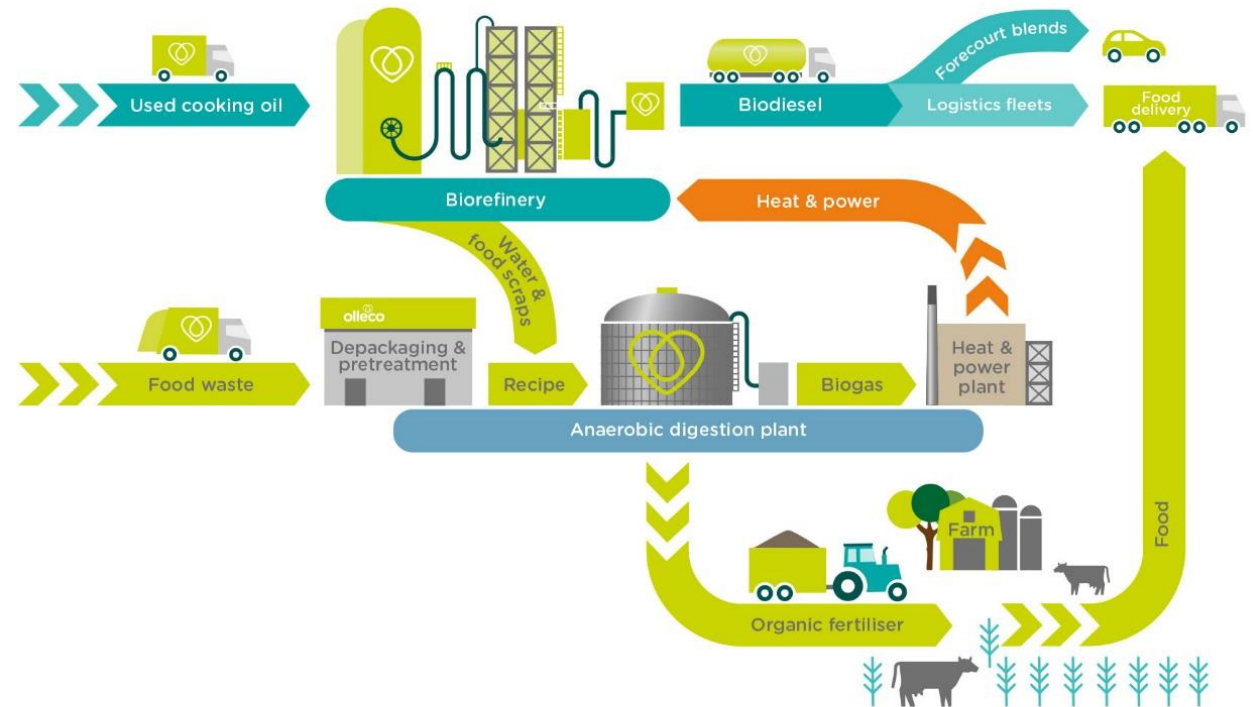


OUR SUSTAINABILITY JOURNEY - TODAY

Wales is currently 3rd in the world for recycling and the Welsh Government has an ambitious target to achieve zero waste by 2050.

ICC Wales has zero waste to landfill and no single use plastic policy.

Our food waste goes to the Anaerobic Digestion Plant where it produces biogas which provides energy to local homes and the byproduct of organic fertiliser goes to local farmers which is used on the land which feeds their animals and completes both the economic and biological cycle.



OUR SUSTAINABILITY JOURNEY - TOMORROW

Whilst we are proud of our journey to date, we recognise that we need to be nimble and evolve so that we can continue to improve and reach our goal of being the most sustainable venue in Europe.

We will continue to build upon our success to date and some of the initiatives that we are developing include:

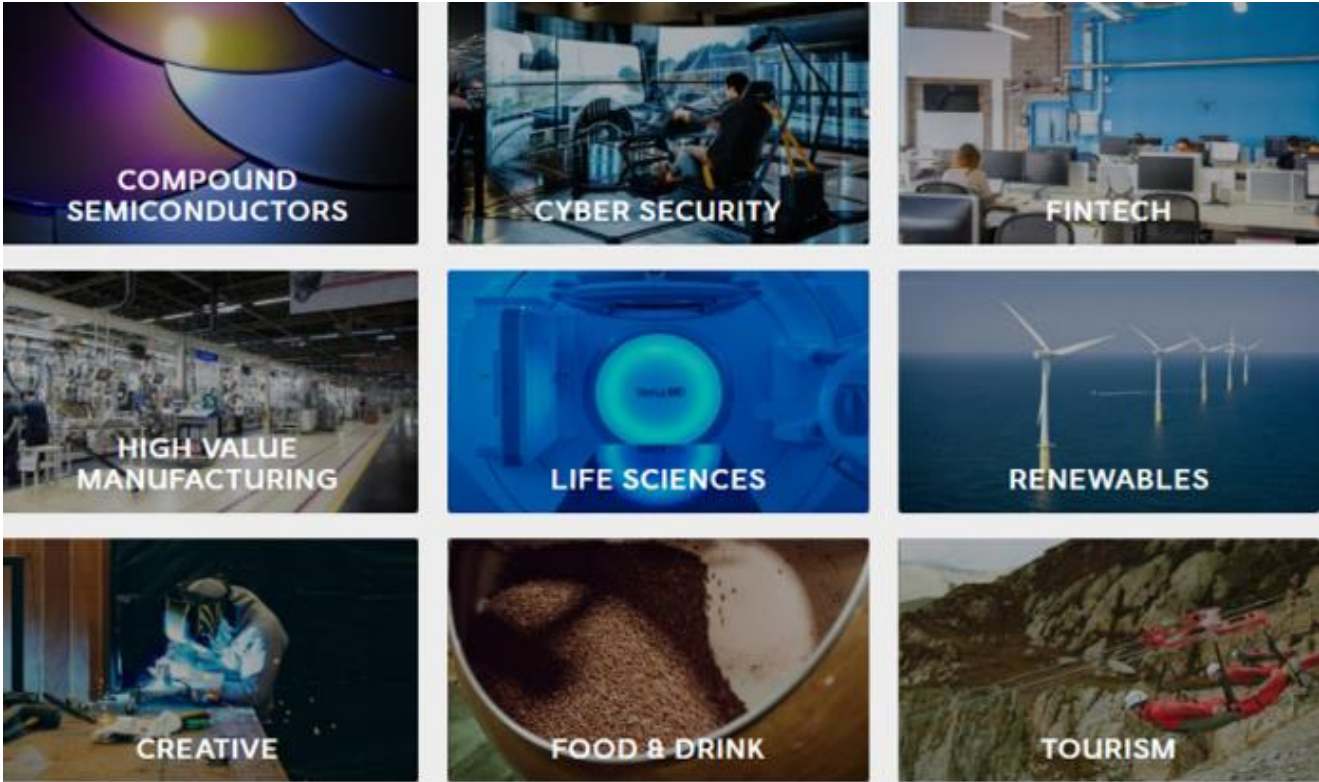
- 3% year on year reduction in energy consumption
- 3% year on year reduction in water consumption
- Electricity for ICC Wales to be generated by solar power within 5 years
- Opening in 2024, our new hotel Ty Newport is one of the first 100% electricity powered hotels in the UK.
- Introduction of beehives into our woodland – we have 8 staff volunteers to become the beekeepers.
- Continue our programme of installing bird boxes, bat boxes and bug hotels into our woodland
- Auditing our ecosystem of indigenous species – flora and fauna

At ICC Wales, our commitment to reducing food waste is an integral part of our sustainability movement. We aim not only to minimise our environmental impact, but also to contribute positively towards the well-being of the surrounding areas.

The Welsh Government has an ambitious target to achieve zero waste in Wales by 2050.



FareShare Cymru is a Cardiff based charity that uses quality, in date surplus food which would otherwise have gone to waste and they turn an environmental problem into a social solution by delivering food to Community Food Members (CFMs) – homeless hostels, community centres, refugee centres.

ICC Wales is working with event organisers to ask their delegates to bring and donate food which our team will co-ordinate to ensure that this worthwhile local charity benefits from the generosity of our visitors.



By their very nature, events can be very wasteful, and Event Cycle is a charity that takes unwanted event waste and gives it a second life – a sustainable solution with a lasting social legacy.

With a commitment to repurposing and giving back to communities, Event Cycle distributes items donated or left behind by events held at ICC Wales amongst charities, community groups and social enterprises, ensuring they find a new purpose for them in Wales rather than see them go to waste.
